TOUR OF THE VILLAS AND PARKS



Varese has been the location of the Cyclism world cup in 1951 and in the 2008 and it is the best place for day trips on bike with the best panoramics landscapes.

Just along the main road there is the ancient **Villa Augusta** built in the '800 sorrounded by the **green area of Giubiano**. Continuing in direction of the city centre you will pass through the main square "Piazza Monte Grappa" and you will arrive at the fantastic Public Gardens that develop behind the town hall "**Palazzo Estense**". Next to the gardens you will find the green area around the **Villa Mirabello** seat of the **Musei Civici** of Varese that keep archeological finds.

Going down a hill you will find yourself at **Villa Recalcati**: nowadays it is a public building that hosts offices. Behind you will find an important french garden with age-old trees and esotic essences.

A little northern there is **Villa Mylius** that is a little paradise with the green area decorated with stone-balustrades, statues and vases.

The historical **Villas of Biumo** ask for a little of dedication because they are located on the top of a hill but the effort is recompensed by two masterpieces: **Villa Ponti** with its immense english park and **Villa Panza** (FAI property) that surprise everyone with its unique contemporary art collection mixed up with the ancient atmosphere of the building.

Going a bit northern again you will find another surprise: the **Villa Toepliz** green park that was planned from a french study enriched in a second time with water-games fountains.

The last two beauties of the itinerary are the **Masnago Castle** and **Villa Baragiola** where, many cultural events and little dedicated exhibition, take place during the year.
